Can someone advise how to interpret the codes used on the back of meet entry forms

am I right in thinking that

101, 102 etc is the the morning of the first day
201, 202 etc is the afternoon of the first day

then

301,302 etc = 2nd day morning

and finally

401, 402 etc = 2nd day afternoon

is that right

this has never been explained nor can I find anywhere on the site that explains it

understanding it is rather important in planning when to arrive - as I recently found out

is something could confirm if I am right or wrong - and if wrong what it does mean

Hi,

those are the event numbers, so 101 is event 01 of session1, 202 is event 02 of session 2 etc.

Normally the front of the entry forms will say how many events there are, some meets may have three events per day so it isn't always true to say that 301 is the 2nd day..

All of the meet information is normally available on the Swimscotland site with sessions, event numbers etc.
